OPINION ON DECISION

1. INJURY AOE/COE

Based upon applicant's testimony and the medical report of Raymond J. Friedman, M.D. dated 4/8/94 and the personnel file from Allied Signal Aerospace it is found that applicant did not injury to his arms, hands, legs, neck, hip, feet and nervous system arising out of and occurring in the course of employment on July 22, 1993.

The Personnel File of the applicant indicates that he reported an injury on or about February 26, 1993 involving metal splinters in his hands. There is no claim for that injury. The only claim that was heard was an alleged injury on July 22, 1993. There is no evidence of any injury on that date. In fact the Applicant testified that during the last two months of his employment he was assigned different job duties. The applicant last worked in August, 1993. His job in July, 1993 did not involve balancing and shaving wheels.

All other issues are moot.
